Started in March 2022, the project will bring together heritage sites and professionals, Universities and research centres, cultural management organizations, communication experts, students' organizations and young citizens from the **6 European participating Countries: Italy, Republic of Serbia, Slovenia, Cyprus, Croatia and Hungary.**

During the 24 months of the project, partners will work together to design two main tools, to be tested and assessed in the participating Countries and therefore available at EU level:

- COOLTOUR digital platform: an innovative digital platform aimed to promote the
 active involvement of Millennials and collect their inputs for the creation of contents
 and storytelling related to cultural heritage. The COOLTOUR platform is a hybrid
 social media web application allowing users to create and share contents related to
 the archaeological sites involved in the project, such as reflections on heritage given
 in vlogs, blogs, inventing new heritage brands, creating heritage inspired emoticons,
 creating routes for "young heritage" as well as heritage presentation from young
 people's perspective, so as to strengthen the link between culture heritage and
 young generations.
- **COOLTOUR toolkit for heritage managers**: an innovative methodology aimed at making the managers of archaeological sites understand the importance of using technology in creating a dialogue with the younger generations.
